Balsam Fir

ABIES BALSAMEA

Very fragrant evergreen often used for Christmas trees. Best grown in rich, consistently moist, slightly acidic, well-drained soils

Height: 50- 70'

Width: 15- 25'

Exposure: Full sun

Soil: Grows poorly in heavy clay.

Habit: Pyramidal

Attributes: Specimen plant.



Marilee® Crabapple

MALUS 'JARMIN'

This crabapple is fruitless with medium green foliage. Dark pink buds open to large, double, almost white flowers.

Height: 24'

Width: 10'

Exposure: Sun

Soil: Average

Habit: Narrow, upright, inverted cone.

Attributes: Resistant to apple scab, fireblight, cedar-apple rust, mildew.



Hardy Rubber Tree

EUCCOMIA ULMOIDES

Low branching tree with broad, ascending branches. Glossy green foliage.

Height: 40-60'

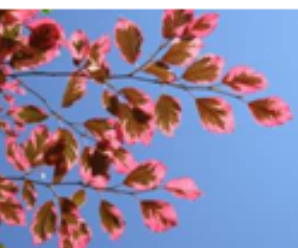
Width: 40-60'

Exposure: Sun

Soil: Average to dry.

Habit: Rounded, spreading.

Attributes: Drought tolerant. Native. Good for naturalizing. Excellent resistance to insect and disease issues.



Tricolor Beech **FAGUS SYLVATICA 'TRICOLOR'**

Height: 20-30'

Width: 10-20'

Soil: Well-drained

Habit: Rounded oval

Attributes: Purple/pink, green and white leaves in spring. No serious insect or disease problems. Deer resistant.



White Oak

QUERCUS ALBA

A long-lived slow-growing shade tree with reliable, long lasting purple-red fall color.

Height: 60- 80'

Width: 30-40'

Exposure: Full sun

Soil: Average

Habit: Rounded, spreading.

Attributes: Drought tolerant, native, good for naturalizing. Tolerates clay and urban conditions.
