Goal: Rigorous Academics

Reading: We will increase the percent proficient of students in grades K-5 from 82.06% to 85% from May 2018 to May 2019 as measured by FAST reading.

Math:
We will increase the percent proficient of students in 4 year old preschool from 60-70% as measured by IGDIs (May 2018-May 2019).

Act Aspire: We will increase student scores in all 4 domains by 5% from 2017-2018 as measured by the ACT Aspire given in spring of 2019.

Reading: We will increase the number of students in grades 3-5 in the advanced category from 25 to 40 from Fall 2018 to April 2019 as measured by Iowa Assessments.

Math: We will increase the percent of students in grades 3-5 proficient from 70.3% to 78% as measured by Iowa Assessment given in April of 2019.
