The Iowa Motor Carriers Foundation (IMCF) is proud to offer scholarships to Iowans pursuing education beyond high school. Scholarships awarded by the Iowa Motor Carriers Foundation are available to students majoring in any field of study at a college or university in Iowa. To be eligible to receive an IMCF scholarship, a student must be a permanent resident of the state of Iowa. The student also must currently be attending or planning to attend any of the following types of educational institutions:

- > A community college located in Iowa
- A public or private trade school located in Iowa
- > A private college or university located in Iowa
- > A public college or university located in Iowa

Selections are based on the applicant's academic record and outside activities as they pertain to school and community citizenship. The scholarships are awarded for the fall semester of the year students apply. It is valid only for that academic year and cannot be held over without the approval of the committee.

You may only apply for <u>one</u> scholarship. If you received a scholarship from the Iowa Motor Carriers Foundation in 2015, you will be <u>ineligible</u> for application until January 1, 2017.

The following scholarships listed are offered by the Iowa Motor Carriers Foundation, you can only apply for ONE SCHOLARSHIP:

- ❖ The **Bob Bannister Memorial Scholarship** was established by family, friends and colleagues in honor of the late Bob Bannister, an active volunteer and avid supporter of the Iowa Motor Truck Association for over 20 years. Bob was known throughout the industry for his knowledge of the industry and his love of the association. This scholarship was established as a way to keep his spirit alive and honor a true friend to Iowa's trucking industry.
