To participate, please submit your Grad Cap design by 3:30pm on Friday, May 6th to Mrs. Borde in the Main Office (Room 11-001). MHS Administration will review your design and approve or deny. Only approved designs will be allowed at the Ceremony so get your design in by the deadline!

Ground Rules For Decorating Graduation Caps

Please follow all of these rules while decorating your graduation cap. Failure to follow these rules will result in your cap being taken away and you may not be able to participate in the Ceremony.

- Cannot any symbols, advertisements, initials, abbreviations, words, slogans, patches or pictures that refer to drugs or controlled substances, tobacco, alcohol, weapons or be of a sexual nature.
- Denote an affiliation with gangs or which advocate drug use, violence, illegal activity, or disruptive behavior which is detrimental to the safety and welfare of other students.
- Nothing obscene, profane, vulgar or lewd.
- Threaten the safety or welfare of any person.
- Only the flat, top area of the cap may be decorated. Nothing can be hanging off from the sides.
- Decorations must be flat on the surface, 3D creations are prohibited.
- No blinking lights, nothing battery operated.
- Make sure the decorations will not come off your cap.
- Do not use anything that will make noise - - no bells, whistles, etc.
- Graduation caps will also be checked on the day of the Ceremony. Any decorated caps not pre-approved or not following the rules will not be allowed and will be at the discretion of MHS Administration. You must have a cap & gown to participate in the Ceremony.

The following is appropriate to put on your cap:

- Thank a parent, grandparent, teacher, or friend
- Recognize the university you will attend
- The year you are graduating
- The branch of the military you will be joining
- Glitter is allowed
