Summer Reading is for all ages! Whether you are a baby, kid, teen, or adult, you can sign up for Summer Reading in person at Musser Library or online at www.musserpubliclibrary.org

How does it work? Kids check out books from Musser Library, read them at home, and log the **time** they spend reading. For every hour of reading, they may come in to the library and claim a prize, up to 6 hours.

For every 100 minutes they read after that, kids receive a ticket to a drawing for prizes at the end of the Summer Program, August 9th.
