MHS Parent/Student Information Meeting for 8th Grade Parents/ Students February 4, 2015

In preparation for the course selection process for the 2015-16 school year, Muscatine High School will be hosting an informational night at **Muscatine High School on Feb. 4th** covering an overview of two topics:

❖ Advanced Placement (AP) Courses (6-7 pm MHS Commons)

(AP Geography is a common 9th Grade AP course taken. 8th grade parents/students are welcome to attend and learn all of the AP courses offered at MHS.)

❖ 8th Grade Parent/Student Transition (7-8 pm MHS Auditorium)

6 pm - 7 pm Advanced Placement (AP) Courses - Muscatine High School Commons

Information will be presented on AP and Pre-AP courses. After a short program, all Advanced Placement teachers will present short break out sessions. These sessions will provide information and expectations specific to each course.

7 pm - 8 pm 8th Grade Transition Information Meeting - Muscatine High School Auditorium

All current 8th grade parents and students are encouraged to attend an informational session regarding the transition from middle school to Muscatine High School. Muscatine High School staff members aim to ease you and your student's transition to the high school and this is the first step to the start of the 2015-16 school year. The following information will be discussed:

- Tips for incoming Muscatine High School freshmen
- Outline of graduation requirements
- Timeline for course selection process and ongoing future orientation activities
- New programs: Honors/Scholar/Freshman Academy
