While health care is primarily the responsibility of the family unit, the MCSD nurses strive to promote a safe and healthy learning environment for all students. The school nurses focus on a holistic approach to minimize the health related barriers to student success.

Services provided by the MCSD nurses include:

- Health related screenings at various grade levels
- Student health education and school staff training
- Illness and injury assessment with first aid treatment and follow-up
- Medication administration
- Creating and maintaining student health records which include immunizations records and dental and vision screenings
- Collaboration with medical providers and student/family in the development of Individualized Health Care Plans
- Collaboration and referral to community agencies
