

Immunizations - Requirement for 12th Grade Students

In late Spring of 2017, changes were made to the Iowa Immunization Law that affected incoming 7th and **12th grade students**. Students in 7th grade need to show proof of receiving one dose of the meningococcal vaccine; **12th grade students need to show proof of at least receiving one dose of the same vaccine, but will need a booster (or second vaccine) to complete the series and be in compliance with Iowa Law.**

Iowa Law states that students who do not show proof of receiving at least one dose of the meningococcal vaccine (or provide the appropriate vaccine exemption certificate) will not be able to attend school. The MCSD plans to be in compliance with Iowa Law and not allow students to attend school on the first day of class if appropriate vaccine paperwork is not in place.

The new Iowa Immunization Law and Meningococcal vaccine requirements have been sent out to all incoming 7th and 12th grade students and families.
