The PreACT Test will be given to all 9th and 10th grade MHS students in November.

November 10th - 10th Grade PreACT Testing

The PreACT predicts student performance on the ACT and is a good indicator of where students are on the path to college readiness.

MY ACADEMIC PLAN (MAP):

This year for individual career and academic planning, we will be using My Academic Plan or MAP. This program will help with career exploration, course planning, college and career readiness, and options beyond high school. Students will complete the Work Values Assessment and a Career Interest Inventory to help them determine which career clusters may be best suited for them.

Students in grades 9-11 will complete their MAP assessments in English classrooms, with Mrs. Hawkins, prior to Thanksgiving.
