**Survivor Week - Monday, March 1st-Friday, March 5th**

Due to the current pandemic situation, Senior Survivor will look a little different this year. We will still be having 2 person teams of a boy and a girl that will fundraise their way into the competition. There will be 5 teams that make it into the week of challenges. However, survivors will not be sleeping at the school and will need to comply with COVID 19 regulations and guidelines.

**Senior Survivor 2021:**

- Students will not be staying at the school overnight, but will need to be here from 7:45 AM until the day's community challenges everyday that week (around 8:00 PM).
- Senior Survivors will compete in challenges throughout the school day and then community challenges in the evening.
- Although we understand that work may be a necessity for some survivors, our hope is that as much time as possible can be taken off of work during the Senior Survivor Week. Please talk to Ms. Heimerdinger, Ms. Warren or Mrs. Walsh if this is a concern.
- We will have opening ceremonies at 5:00 PM in the commons on Monday, March 1st and closing ceremonies will be at 4:00 PM in the commons on Friday, March 5th.

**Understand that all the prior rules on the Senior Survivor Participant Packet remain in effect and the following rules have been added for the week of survivor:**

- Survivors will be awarded points for completed challenges. Failure to complete challenges will result in negative points.
- Specific challenges will result in bonus prizes for winning Survivor teams
- Individual contests and events will have individual rules
- Survivors must be in the library or an approved area during their free time.
- As previously stated in the Senior Survivor sign-up packet, class attendance is required of survivors (this includes college classes). Failure to do so will result in loss of points.
- Additional rules can be added by Ms. Heimerdinger Mrs. Walsh or Ms. Warren at any time if found necessary.

**Here are some additional reminders with point deductions and rules:**

- One of your team members must have control of your flag at all times. If another team has it, there will be a 5 point deduction
- If you find someone's flag, it needs to be taken to Ms. Heimerdinger's room (11-028).
- A missing shirt is a 5 point deduction.
- You are in charge of scheduling your alternate. You must have an alternate present for every minute you are not present.
- If you have a bad attitude, protest or miss a challenge, 5 points will be deducted at a minimum. It is up to the advisor's discretion to disqualify a competitor at any point for bad behavior.
- Senior survivors run on a tight schedule, so time is of the essence. If you're not on time, there will be a 2 point deduction.
- Senior Survivor is supposed to be a fun experience for everyone. If people continuously complain about what they are doing, it won't be fun for anyone.
- Stay positive throughout the frustration and challenging pieces. It will make the experience more enjoyable for everyone!
- \$54.75 will be deducted to absorb the costs of t-shirts for survivors.
