FALL



On track to Graduate- meet with your Counselor.
ACT if you aren't satisfied with your score as a junior and want to take it again.

College Applications- research schools of interest, submit applications to at-least two or three schools.

Visit with college and military representatives.

FAFSA- visit www.fafsa.gov to complete this form. State funded grant programs have limited funds, apply early! Get help in the student services office.

Resume/ Essay/ Recommendation letters

Apply for Scholarships- You should **NEVER** pay for scholarships.

Early decision or early action applications due in November.

Transcript/ACT Score request -request transcripts in the student services office.



College Applications hard deadline - Many popular and selective colleges will have application deadlines as early as January 1.

Receive/ review Acceptance letters and financial aid offers.

May 1- college commitment deadline for many schools.
